- November 1, 2015 – ALL COMPETITION & COSTUME MONEY DUE! Cash or Check only.

Every year the competitions fill up fast. We will be entering all of our dancers at the beginning of the year to ensure our spots.

Rules:

- You must take the technique class assigned to your performing group AND acro/stretch class
- You must take at least one ballet class.
- Positive working attitudes are expected at all times.
- NO CELL PHONES during class time.
- Leave personal issues outside the studio. Once you are in class all of your focus will be devoted to your work.
- Besides your academics, performing group is the priority you are committing to.
- Come prepared for each class with the appropriate attire and shoes.

ATTENDANCE:

- Be on time for each class.
- No more than ONE absence per month, per class, on average
- You are required to do a make- up class for each absence.
- If you cannot follow these attendance requirements you will be given one warning before being dropped from the performing group.

Examples of acceptable reasons for missing class:

- Illness
- Emergencies
- MUN conferences
- ACT and SAT testing

Examples of unacceptable reasons for missing class:

- Voluntary events (schedule them when you don't have class)
- Hair done for an event, including Nutcracker
- Dentist or Doctor appointments (only ok in emergencies)
- Birthday parties and social events

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT COMPETITIONS AND CONVENTIONS:

- Please arrive at the competition TWO HOURS prior to scheduled competing time. Parking can be difficult and sometimes the event may run early.
- Please arrive ONE HOUR prior to convention beginning time. We will designate a place to meet and register as a studio together.
- Competitions are free to observe, however conventions usually charge an observer fee if you wish to watch the classes.

If you are new to Performing Group you will need to order a Performing Group Jacket. The cost is around \$50.00 Please let the office know that you need to place an order.
